- One of the students receiving the McConnell Scholarship must live in Ohio. The other student receiving the McConnell Scholarship will be selected from the pool of applicants throughout the U.S.

- 1. Provide two letters of nomination/recommendation (if enrolled in an AIT program, one must be from your preceptor, or, if a student, one must be from your advisor/professor; and
- 2. Prepare a one page paper describing your intentions for your future in long term care administration (i.e. your goals, what drives you to excel, what you believe your contributions will be to the profession, etc.)
- 3. Note that this scholarship is administered by the Ohio Chapter of ACHCA. Recipients must attend the ACHCA Convocation in St. Louis, MO from April 1-5, 2017 to have his/her award announced. The recipient will be notified 45 days before Convocation so he/she can plan on attending. The deadline for submission is January 9, 2017.
