In addition, a student poster exposition, awards luncheon, and social activities will allow professional networking and peer-to-peer learning. Attendees will visit with over 50 of the leading product and service companies dedicated to providing the latest cost-effective and state-of-the-art resident care solutions. ACHCA will also hold two Idea Exchange sessions which offer a unique educational opportunity for face to face interaction between conference participants and industry experts about innovative care and service concepts.
