ACHCA's President & CEO, Bill McGinley, Announces Retirement

Washington, DC – March 15, 2021 – Bill McGinley, President and CEO of The American College of Health Care Administrators has announced his intent to retire after the ACHCA Convocation this year. It is expected that he will hand over the reins to a successor chosen by the ACHCA board of directors near the end of May this year.

McGinley has been in the position since November 2017. Under his tenure membership in the organization has grown as has the profile of ACHCA.

This caps a 41-year career in the field of long-term care administration for McGinley. He joined ACHCA upon becoming a licensed nursing home administrator in February 1982.

In 2017 he became the President and CEO of ACHCA. Reflecting on the move to ACHCA, McGinley felt that it was a job for which he had been preparing his entire career.

During his tenure, the organization has seen an increase in membership and has raised its public profile. McGinley says that he is particularly proud of the collaborations that occurred with industry partners such as AHCA, APAACN, NAHCA, and AMDA during the pandemic. Many of these collaborations advocated for profession of long-term care and post-acute administrators as well as providing needed education.

Commenting on his retirement, ACHCA Board Chair Bob Lane said, "Over the course of his three-year tenure, Bill has stabilized our operations, enhanced ACHCA's visibility in the post-acute community, and set us back on a successful course. His relatability, level head and dedication to this association will be missed tremendously. On a personal note, I've thoroughly enjoyed working with Bill, especially as we navigated our way through this past year, and I wish him and his wife Sue the very best as they transition into a new season of life!"

Incoming board chair Theresa Sanderson thanked Bill for his years of service to the long-term care industry, and especially to ACHCA and offered her best wishes for a long and healthy retirement.
